Freaky animal sounds

Anime is a word used by people living outside Japan to describe cartoons or animations produced in Japan. Using a word in an English conversation is basically the same as describing something as a Japanese cartoon series or an animated movie or show from Japan. The word itself is simply a Japanese word for cartoon or animation and in Japan it is used by people to describe all cartoons regardless of country of origin.
